**Day 1: Monday, September 20, 2027 Overnight Flight** Ancient castles and Roman ruins, groves of orange and almond trees, quiet whitewashed villages, and welcoming locals – Portugal is waiting for you.

**Day 2: Tuesday, September 21, 2027 Porto, Portugal** Arrive in Porto, a former industrial city steeped in history. With no scheduled sightseeing today, spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. Porto's Baroque and modernist architecture blend to create an artistic heritage that's earned a UNESCO designation. Here, you'll find quiet cafés perfect for sipping a glass of port wine and watching the world go by. Depending on your flight arrival time, join your Tour Manager and fellow travelers this evening for a welcome reception at your hotel.

**Day 3: Wednesday, September 22, 2027 Porto - Vila Nova de Gaia - Porto** Begin with a walking tour led by a local expert, exploring charming cobblestone streets and the vibrant atmosphere Porto is known for. As you make your way towards the Palácio da Bolsa, pass by the São Bento Railway Station, renowned for its *azulejo* (tile) panels depicting scenes from Portuguese history. At Palácio da Bolsa (Stock Exchange Palace), take in the grandeur of the Arab Room with its lavish Moorish-inspired decor. Then stroll through the historic Ribeira District, a UNESCO World Heritage site, bursting with colorful building facades and lively riverside cafés. Next, cross the bridge into the neighboring city of Vila Nova de Gaia, tracing the historic paths of Portugal's wine merchants. Tour a traditional wine cellar, indulging in the rich flavors of vintage wines that have made this region famous worldwide, before returning to the hotel with a breathtaking view of the city. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (B, D)

**Day 4: Thursday, September 23, 2027 Porto - Braga - Porto** Depart from Porto and travel north to the charming village of Barcelos, where you'll immerse yourself in rich artisan traditions and a vibrant local culture that can truly be felt only here. Continue to Braga, where you'll explore the historic city center with time to enjoy its elegant squares, ancient monuments, and lively streets. Afterward, make your way to the iconic Bom Jesus do Monte Sanctuary, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Ascend the hill aboard the historic hydraulic funicular, the oldest operating funicular of its kind in the world and take in the breathtaking panoramic views from the top. Explore the Baroque stairways, serene gardens, and symbolic chapels that give this sanctuary its remarkable spirit, before returning to Porto for a leisurely evening. (B)

**Day 5: Friday, September 24, 2027 Porto - Aveiro - Cascais** This morning, say goodbye to Porto. En route to the Portuguese Riviera, enjoy some free time to experience the city of Aveiro. This enchanting city is known for its canals and its egg-yolk desserts, loved by the Portuguese, and has a rich history and heritage fueled by its canals and the Atlantic Ocean. As you arrive in the Portuguese Riviera, mansions scattered throughout Cascais hint at this area's history as a haven for exiled European royals and nobility. Settle into your hotel before joining your fellow travelers for dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

**Day 6: Saturday, September 25, 2027 Cascais - Óbidos - Sintra - Cascais** Explore the picture-perfect city of Óbidos, where white-washed houses sit snug within medieval city walls, and toast with a ginjinha, a sour cherry liqueur served in a small chocolate cup. Continue to Sintra (UNESCO), a breathtaking hub that served as the summer residence of Portuguese kings for six centuries. Then, **it's your choice!** Explore the quaint hilltop village of Sintra and take some time to wander through its winding streets **-OR-** join a guided tour of the National Palace of Sintra, considered the best-preserved medieval palace in Portugal. **Day 7: Sunday, September 26, 2027 Cascais - Évora** Today, make your way through Portugal's charming countryside as your journey takes you to Évora, a UNESCO-listed city steeped in over 2,000 years of history. Explore the medieval walled town with a local expert, admiring its narrow, cobbled streets, Roman architecture, and the remarkable first-century Roman Temple. Visit the Chapel of Bones, where the walls are intricately lined with the bones and skulls of thousands of former residents. The afternoon is yours to wander at leisure or simply relax. Later, you may choose to join an optional excursion to learn about the region's centuries-old cork harvesting traditions, ending with a flavorful Alentejo dinner. *(B)*

**Day 8: Monday, September 27, 2027 Évora - Lagos** Journey to the stunning coasts of the Algarve – the southernmost region of Portugal. On the way, visit a local gin distillery. Learn how one man took a homemade drink and implemented traditional Portuguese stills and local ingredients to craft a premium gin. Savor the flavors of these botanicals before continuing your journey south. Indulge in full-bodied wines of the Alentejo over lunch. This evening, explore the historic resort town of Lagos, where Moorish and Renaissance influences meet towering seaside cliffs. Many celebrated voyagers began their explorations from this bustling port. *(B, L)*

**Day 9: Tuesday, September 28, 2027 Lagos** Enjoy a full day experiencing the Algarve at your own pace. Lagos, with its golden beaches, dramatic cliffs, and a relaxed coastal atmosphere, invites you to explore. Wander the historic old town, stroll along the

marina, or follow the scenic coastal paths toward Ponta da Piedade, with its breathtaking sea views and iconic rock formations. You may choose to join an optional boat tour\*\* combining the thrill of spotting wild dolphins with a visit to Portugal's stunning coastal caves. *(B, D)*

**Day 10: Wednesday, September 29, 2027 Lagos - Silves - Lagos** This morning, venture inland to Silves, a once-mighty Moorish capital that still carries the quiet charm of a sleepy hillside town. As you approach, the red sandstone walls of Silves Castle rise above whitewashed houses, creating one of the Algarve's most striking contrasts. Enjoy time to explore at your own pace, or choose to climb to the castle, Portugal's best-preserved Moorish fortress. Later, visit a local winery set among the sun-drenched hills, where you'll learn about the region's winemaking traditions while savoring local wines, all paired with magnificent rural views. Return to Lagos for an evening at leisure. *(B)*

**Day 11: Thursday, September 30, 2027 Lagos - Azeitão - Lisbon** En route to Lisbon, pause for a truly local lunch at an unexpected spot that captures the region's genuine flavors. Afterwards, continue to Azeitão, a picturesque village celebrated for its exquisite hand-painted tiles. Meet local artisans in a family-run workshop and learn how Portugal's iconic *azulejos* are crafted. Continue your journey to your last destination, Lisbon, Portugal's vibrant capital city. Tonight, you may choose to join an optional tour to listen to local artists perform traditional *Fado* music, a UNESCO intangible cultural heritage highlight. *(B, L)*

**Day 12: Friday, October 1, 2027 Lisbon** Get ready for a full and intense day of discovery. Begin your day with a local expert in Portugal's vibrant capital. Journey to Belém to admire the iconic 16th-century Jerónimos Monastery (a UNESCO World Heritage Site) and discover the pivotal role of the Age of Discoveries in shaping Portugal's history. Then decide how you want to explore Lisbon, because **it's your choice!** Discover the art and tradition of Portuguese sidewalks during a locally led walking tour **-OR-** venture with your Tour Manager on foot and discover the city through the lens of the businesses and streets connected with the country's most loved fish, *bacalhau* (salted codfish). Savor a farewell dinner to Portugal at a restaurant beloved by locals, celebrating the perfect ending to your unforgettable journey. (B, D)

### Important Tour Information:

**The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3.** This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

#### **Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).**

During your Choice on Tour in Lisbon, one of the walks requires 2 miles on cobblestone streets with uphill sections.

Porto is a compact city with many hills, cobblestone streets and uneven ground. Our Porto visit will take approximately 3 hours and you should be prepared to stand for longer periods of time.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Portugal has strict regulations on where tour buses can circulate, with mandatory drop off and pick up points, especially in historic areas like Lisbon, Porto, Óbidos, and Aveiro. In Lisbon and Porto, be prepared to walk around 3 miles (4.8 km) to complete the sightseeing, with limited chances to sit. The full day walking tour takes place on mostly flat terrain, but streets are cobblestoned, sidewalks are narrow, and areas are often crowded. For your comfort and safety, we recommend wearing comfortable walking shoes.

This tour covers a total of 1400 miles/ 995kms in 12 days, with the longest transfer day being a 4-hour drive covering 215 miles/350kms from Porto to Cascais and a 4-hour drive covering 215 miles/350kms from Lagos to Lisbon.

This tour offers the option to add up to three optional excursions, which provide extra value and authentic local experiences. However, if you

choose to include all three, the sightseeing schedule will become quite full, with limited opportunities for rest.

#### Day 13: Lisbon - Funchal, Madeira

Fly to Madeira Island, the "Pearl of the Atlantic" where you arrive in the early afternoon. Madeira boasts a subtropical climate, majestic mountain ranges and volcanic caves. After free time for lunch on your own in the colorful Santa Maria district, go on a walking tour of Funchal's old downtown with its quaint narrow streets and historical sites, such as a 15th-century cathedral. Visit the Botanical Garden of Madeira with its collection of more than 2,500 plants from all continents.

#### Day 14: Funchal - Câmara de Lobos - Porto Moniz - Funchal

Begin your day with a tour that takes you to Câmara de Lobos, a traditional village on a picture-perfect bay that served as a special retreat for Sir Winston Churchill. It was here that Madeira's natural beauty captivated him and inspired many of his paintings of the island. Drive along mountain roads, passing banana plantations and vineyards while en route to the world's second-highest cliff, Cabo Girão. After, visit an immersive and artistic-themed center focused entirely on the banana before leaving for the fishing village of Porto Moniz.\* Here, enjoy free time before returning to Funchal. *Today breakfast will be included.*

#### Day 15: Funchal

The day is yours. During your free time, you may choose to visit the Sacred Art Museum and learn how the sugar-cane trade allowed for the purchase of Flemish art dating back to the 15th century. Or simply relax and enjoy the amenities that your hotel has to offer. Then gather in the evening for a traditional dinner known as an *espetada*.\*\* Folk dancers and lively music entertain you as you feast on a favorite local dish cooked over an open fire. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

#### Day 16: Funchal - Lisbon, Portugal

**The overall activity level of this extension is a level 2.** This means you can partake in a two-hour walking tour covering up to 2 miles (including breaks), over a variety of terrains. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease and handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

**This is a Hosted Extension.** Enjoy a mix of time on your own and some planned tour activities. A local expert is available during part of your stay to guide you during scheduled activities and provide recommendations.
